School Bus Rules

- ✓ Arrive at your pick up location five minutes before scheduled pick up time.
- ✓ Once boarded, sit facing the front of the bus with legs and bags out of the aisle and remain in your seat until you reach your destination.
- ✓ Do not distract the driver from their responsibility of driving the bus. Keep the noise level down. No yelling, screaming, fighting, throwing objects or use of profanity.
- ✓ Eating or drinking is not permitted on the bus.
- ✓ Opening and closing of windows is permitted by the bus driver only.
- ✓ Keep your arms, hands and head inside the bus.
- ✓ Be respectful of others and their property. Keep your hands to yourself. Do not leave garbage on the bus.
- ✓ Do not damage the bus, interior or exterior.
- ✓ No smoking on the bus.
- ✓ When you arrive at your destination, remain in your seat until the bus comes to a full stop.
- ✓ Unloading at the school is done one seat at a time, beginning with the front seat. Remain in your seat until it is your turn.
- ✓ Adhere to departure times at your school.
- ✓ Skateboards, skates, etc., must be enclosed in a cloth bag and stored under the seat. The bus driver and principal will be responsible for deciding which items can be brought on the bus.
- ✓ Refer to regulation EEAEC-R/JICC-R for more information.

Dear Parents/Guardians:

RE: Purchase Seat Applications

The St. James-Assiniboia School Division will soon be in the process of setting up student busing for the 2017-18 school year. Each year, parents wishing to purchase a seat on a Division bus must re-apply for a seat.

There are no guarantees for purchase seating. Once all students eligible for busing according to provincial legislation have been identified, bus routes are designed and possible purchase seats for each run are identified. Purchase seat applications received prior to April 30th of each year will be considered in the design of bus routes. However, purchase seats are always dependent on availability, on a first come, first served basis.

In order to be considered for a purchase seat prior to the end of the current school year, the attached application and post-dated cheques must be submitted to the school at this time. Late submissions (after April 30th) will likely result in a significant wait time for a bus at the beginning of the year. Finalizing bus runs usually takes most of September so late applications may not be processed until the middle part of October.

The rate for purchase seats for next year remains the same as this year - \$44.00/month for the first child, \$22.00 for each additional child. One-way purchase seats are also available. Please enclose ten post-dated cheques (dated the 1st of each month) **made payable to Golden Gate Middle School** in order that the school can submit your application to the Transportation Department.

If you do not receive confirmation of a seat prior to the end of June from the school, this likely means that a purchase seat is not currently available on the bus. The school will contact you either way in order for you to be able to make alternate arrangements for transporting your child to school. If you are on a wait list, the school will let you know at this time. If at any time you decide that you do not plan to purchase a seat next year, please let the school office know.
