2017-2018 Student Basic Supply List & Information

Supplies for grade 6, 7 & 8 students

- 2 glue sticks (36 g)
- 1 geometry set (to be used for all 3 years)
- 1 highlighter
- 1 pair of scissors
- 12 blue or black ink pens
- 4 red pens
- 12 pencils hb (sharpened)
- 2 pencil erasers
- 1 pkg. pencil crayons-set of 24 (sharpened)
- 1 pencil case
- 1 pencil sharpener (with container attachment to hold the shavings)
- 1 pkg. Hilroy graph paper (quad 10 to 1cm) 8 ½ x 11 (20 sheets total)
- 3 pkgs. paper – 3 hole loose leaf lined (450 sheets total)
- 6 duotangs
- 4 scribblers (do not label – to be handed to various teachers)
- 4 2-pocket folders (to create portfolios)
- 2 2" or 3" inch, 3 ring, zipper binders
- 3 pkgs. subject dividers
- 1 31 cm/12" ruler
- 1 pair headphones with 1/8" connector-like those for ipods etc.(for computer class only – for a maximum of 1/3 of the year in rotation – strongly recommended and quite inexpensive if not purchased at a specialty outlet)
- 1 box facial tissue (give to homeroom teacher on first day)
- 1 calculator
- 1 English dictionary

Please keep one-half of the loose leaf, writing utensils, glue and erasers at home until needed. Please send to the school in January to replenish student supplies.

Be sure to label ALL of your child's equipment! If there is no name, it is impossible to return the items to their proper owners.

General & Program Specific Fees & Supplies

The supplies and fees listed below are required for the non-academic programming that your child will take part in at school. Please note that most fees listed below will be **collected using School Cash Online**, our secure online payment system. The system will be opened for account creation and payment on **Monday August 28th, 2017**. We have attached instructions for account creation and how to pay for the fees.

Students using school *large* instruments will be assigned a separate fee for instrument rental, also through School Cash Online.

Physical Education

For movement, safety, and health (hygiene) reasons it is **mandatory** that students have the following items for each PE/HE class:

- Athletic shoes (runners, cross trainers, court shoes)
 - **Note: skate shoes, fashion runners and flip flops will not be permitted**
- Athletic crew-neck T-shirt
- Athletic shorts or sweat pants (preferably without pockets, zippers, snaps)
- Unscented stick or roll-on deodorant (non-aerosol, no body sprays)
- Gym bag

For safety reasons, students are expected to remove jewelry during PE/HE classes, Intramurals, and all Gator Athletics programs.

Please label all items within the gym bag and remind your child to take everything home on the weekends to be laundered.

Home Economics

Grade 6 students will be provided with apron project supplies.

All students in grades 7 and 8 are expected to have an apron. (It is a requirement that an apron be worn when preparing food).

Locks and lockers

Each student will be assigned a locker by the homeroom teacher. A combination lock is rented to the student for the year. The student must use the lock assigned by the school as the administration is allowed access to any locker at any time. If a lock is misplaced, lost or willfully damaged, the student will be assessed a replacement fee of \$5.00. The school cannot assume responsibility for the loss of student property from the locker.
